



Information Sheet on the free annual student ticket

1. Who is entitled to a free annual student ticket?

- All students: in year 1 to 10 of general education schools
- Children who attend a kindergarten schools or who take part in special language support programmes
- Students: in year 11 and 12 at special schools specialising in mental development
- Student: at vocational entry schools
- Students: in the first year of vocational schools, so far as the pupils attend these without a lower secondary school certificate (Realschulabschluss)
if the child
attends primary school in the school district of the place of residence
or
attends the next school of the school type in the secondary school sector
and
the walking distance to the school is at least 2 kilometres for primary schools or at least 3 kilometres for secondary schools.

2. How is the claim asserted?

The claim is subject to application. The application must be submitted online. You can find the link to the application on the page [Schülerfahrtkosten | Landkreis Nienburg](#) or with the following QR-Code



3. When is the annual school ticket issued?

The school year ticket will be issued by the school on the first school days after the start of the school year. If the child is not entitled to a school year ticket, you will receive a letter of refusal from the district.

Due to the fact that the ticket is only issued after the start of the school year, pupils will be transported without a valid school year ticket for the first 10 days after the start of the school year!

4. What happens if an application is submitted within the current school year?

An application can be submitted at any time. When submitting an application, please refer to point 2. A temporary travel pass (14-day certificate) can be issued for the duration of the application being sent, checked and returned. This temporary ticket is issued by the school. Please contact the school office.
